



## NC COMMUNITY HEALTH WORK

This Qualification is for any individual who is, or wishes to be, involved in Ancillary Health Care services. A learner who has achieved this qualification will integrate a range of basic awareness and competences to perform the roles of health promoter, assistant or health provider and assist the health networker within a community development context.

It will also assist those who have worked in this field for many years, but have no formal recognition of knowledge and skills that they have acquired non-formally but would like to achieve this recognition through the process of Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and/or formal study

Learners who complete this qualification will have better self and social awareness and will possess a wider range of skills to better understand and function in the ancillary health care field in various community contexts e.g. first aid, health promotion, HIV/AIDS and STIs, home based healthcare etc. Upon completion, learners will provide a service that will assist communities to better manage their own health and wellness.

They will have the skills to support team members and assist in the provision of support services within a multi-disciplinary health care team. Practitioners will generally carry out their roles within the context of the client's home, a community care centre, NGOs, department of health clinical facilities and/or the broader community.
